

EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

1. "District policy requires students in grades 4-12 to maintain a 'C' average in all subjects as a condition of participation in extra-curricular activities. Students in grades 4-12 who do not maintain a 'C' average on the twelve-week, semester, or equivalent report card will be ineligible to participate in any and all extra-curricular activities..."
2. Definition of extracurricular activities -Bulletin No. 12
 - A. "'Activity' is defined as performance, practice, and non-classroom assignments related to extracurricular programs.
 - B. Extracurricular activities are not part of the regular school curriculum, are not graded, do not earn credits, generally take place out of classroom time, and often involve performance before an audience or spectators.
 - C. Some extracurricular activities may be connected with curriculum experience in a regular classroom situation (e.g., band, football team, drama, journalism, etc.). When this is the case, care must be taken to differentiate participation for an ineligible student. He/she may continue as part of the class and earn the mark and credits even though ineligible to participate in out-of-classroom activity, performances or competition. Students will not be penalized or have a course mark lowered because of ineligibility to participate in the extracurricular portion of the activity."
